SCHEME FOR GRANT-IN-AID TO NON-PROFIT/NON-GOVERNMENTAL AYUSH ORGANISATIONS/INSTITUTIONS FOR UPGRADATION TO CENTRES OF EXCELLENCE

I. Introduction:

Given the growing consumer acceptance of AYUSH in the domestic and global society as an important component of pluralistic schemes of healthcare, the Govt. of India has decided to identify reputed AYUSH knowledge institutions in Non-Governmental/Private Sector and support them to upgrade *their functions and facilities* to levels of excellence. The Centers of Excellence may be institutions engaged in one or more of the following activities:

Clinical research, Nursing hospitals and homes, Fundamental research based on the Fundamentals of AYUSH, Inter-disciplinary research in Pharmacognosy, pharmacology, pharmacy or product development, bridging AYUSH and modern science, AYUSH Informatics, Any other specialized area of AYUSH.

II Objective of the Scheme:

To support creative and innovative proposals for upgrading both functions and facilities of reputed AYUSH institutions to levels of excellence. Upgrading functions implies adding new long-term functions or making significant qualitative improvements in the existing functions. It also includes support for human resources who will be attached to the new functions. Upgrading facilities also implies adding infrastructure or equipments that will result in a qualitative

improvement.

III Eligibility under the scheme:

The applicants should be reputed non-profit AYUSH knowledge institutions in Non-Governmental/Private Sector engaged in one or more of the above fields listed in the introduction to the scheme.

The applicants should have a track record of atleast *ten years* of meritorious work in the AYUSH sector.

The applicant should have a competent *core staff* in the field in which the Centre of Excellence is proposed

The applicant should have a credible governance structure and reputed persons on its management committee.

Any institution that has obtained funding from any other Central Government Ministry/ Department for the same purpose in the last five years shall not be eligible for funding under this scheme.

Applicant shall have to make information available regarding any assistance taken from any State/Central Agency in the last 5 years.

IV. Duration of the Scheme:

The Scheme will be operational during XIth Plan. There will be a periodic review of the Scheme on yearly basis for mid-term corrections, if required.

V. Mode of application

Application for upgradation to Centers of Excellence shall be made in the proforma at

Annexure.

VI. Whom to apply.

Director (Schemes), Dept. of Ayurveda, Yoga & Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy, Indian Red Cross Society Building Annexe, Red Cross Road, Opp. Parliament House, New Delhi.

VII. Selection process:

1. The scheme shall be announced on the AYUSH website and brochures on the scheme should be widely distributed to all potential applicant constituencies.

2. Any applicant should be free to send a brief concept note which should information on

a) Proposed objectives of excellence and their justification;

b) Track record of meritorious accomplishments during the last ten years;

c) Profile of available staff and infrastructure;

d) Information on National and International awards;

e) Broad budget estimate for a five year program; and

f) Recommendation from two renowned experts in the field of sciences/medicine.

3. Concept notes approved by the selection committee should be invited to submit a full proposal through the concerned State Govt. with due recommendation.

4. The Accreditation-cum-Project Appraisal Committee will review and select the best proposal evaluated in terms of:

i) Bonafides of the organization for accreditation.

ii) Scientific relevance of objectives for excellence.

iii) Last ten years track record of the applicant.

iv) Strengths and limitations of the existing functions and facilities.

v) Anticipated outputs and outcomes during the next five years

vi) Quality of governance system of the applicant institutions.

5. Any Institution that has obtained funding from any other Central Government Ministry/Department in the last five years shall not be eligible for funding under this Scheme.

VIII. Funding Pattern

The Grant-in-aid will be issued direct to the organisation in three installments as follows. 1st installment : 40% of sanction granted to the project.

2nd Installment : 40% of sanction on submission of UC & review of progress.

3rd & final installment : 20% of sanction after submission of UC and review of progress. The Grantee institution is required to make a request for release of 2nd and 3rd installments giving reference to the sanction alongwith utilisation certificate and a report on the progress of the scheme. The grantee institution is also required to submit a Bank Guarantee before release of grant-in-aid to it.

XII. Certificate to be submitted with the application

- 1. We shall abide by all the Terms and Conditions of the Grant.
- 2. We shall furnish such periodical / special reports as may be required by Department of AYUSH.
- 3. Our books and records shall be open to inspection at all times to Department of AYUSH or their authorized representatives.
- 4. Department of AYUSH may at their discretion, themselves or through their authorized representative evaluate the physical progress / utilization of funds for the projects.
- 5. The undersigned shall be personally responsible for the credibility and authenticity of the information provided and documents attached with the proposal and legally liable for any default in this regard.
- 6. Separate accounts for the project will be maintained.
- 7. In the event of the default or deviation from the terms and conditions of sanction of the projects, the Department of AYUSH shall have the right to forfeit the Bank Guarantee submitted by the organization prior to release of grant-in-aid.

XIII. Agreement

The applicant institution is required to sign an agreement with the Department of AYUSH before sanction of grant-in-aid for implementation of the project within a time frame. In the event of failure to implement the project within the stipulated time frame the applicant institution will be liable for penalty as decided by the Dept.
